This competition gives undergraduate and graduate health education majors the opportunity to display their expertise the evening before ARSOPHE's Annual Conference. Teams of two to three students are challenged to solve a real-world health issue using the competencies required for a school or community health educator.

Case scenarios were provided to registered teams two weeks before the competition. Students have been working to prepare their response to their assigned case scenario, which they will then present at ARSOPHE's Annual Pre-Conference Competition. Each team is required to present their response to the Case Study using a 10-15 minute oral presentation followed by a 10-15 minute Question and Answer Session after their presentation. Students are limited to using PowerPoint only for their presentation to the judges.

As part of your conference registration, you are cordially invited to attend the Case Competition to participate in the Q & A Session with the student teams to aid in their professional development. The winners of the case study competition will be identified at ARSOPHE's Annual Conference Luncheon the next day.
